English We will be learning to:

- Write a character description
- Write a discussion text
- Develop our handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Develop our reading skills

Maths We will be learning to:

- Apply different addition and subtraction strategies
- Multiply 2-digits by 1-digit
- Develop our confidence with recall of multiplication facts
- Tell the time to the nearest minute

Science We will be learning to:

- Compare and group materials into solids, liquids or gases
- Research the temperature at which states of matter change
- Understand the water cycle
- Explain evaporation

RE We will be learning to:

- Recount the story of Jesus and the blind man
- Analyse the meaning of the word 'miracle'
- Explore Christians' beliefs about Jesus's miracles
- Think creatively about a miracle we would like to perform

Geography We will be learning to:

- Explain how animals have adapted to survive in the North and South Poles
- Recount Shackleton's attempts to reach the South Pole
- Analyse the leadership skills of Shackleton
- Investigate the potential impact of the melting of the polar ice caps

To research a different explorer and present your information as a poster.

To write a day plan, with times, for a day on your own expedition (real or imaginary!)

To draw a picture of a character from a book that you are reading this term.

To create your own clock using any materials. Use it to practise telling the time.
