All children/Tuck Shop:

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Year 6/Bartholomew Transition Day: Thursday 18th April, 9.00-2.30pm The coach will collect and return the children from and to school.

All children/Bank Holiday: Monday 6th May

Year 1&2/Dance Festival, Bartholomew School: Friday 3rd May, 9.00-11.00am
Year 3&4/Dance Festival, Bartholomew School: Wednesday 8th May, 9.00-11.00am
These festivals will be run at Bartholomew School. All of the children are expected to go to this as part of their school curriculum. We will be asking parents to drop the children off in the morning at the school and will organise a coach to bring them back. *More details will follow*.

All children/Little Loaves Service: Thursday 9th May

Nursery and Murphy (Reception) class will be holding their sports day between 9.15-10.30am. The rest of the school will be between 1.30-3.00pm. Parents are welcome to attend.

Some year 5&6 children/EPA Cricket Tournament: Tuesday 21st May

This tournament will take place after school, venue yet to be decided. Selection will be closer to the time and letters will be sent to parents.

Years 1-5/Overnight Camp on the school field: Thursday 23rd May
